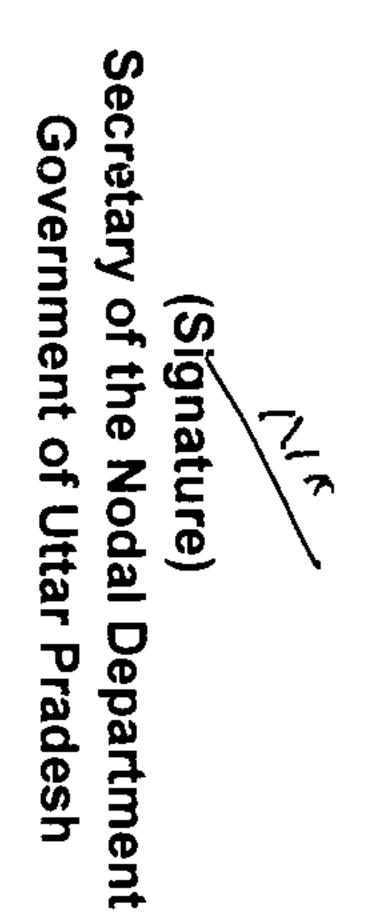

Gist of findings

- Management information System (MIS) should be developed and should be integrated with SMS services from the school to avoid the problems of inaccurate information or delayed response.
- Institutional connections of LPG should be given to the schools. The difference in LPG Cylinder Colour and Size will certainly check the mishappenings.
- The government should either scout for large NGOs or shift the MDM activities to the schools with proper arrangement of manpower.
- A Mid Day Meal Menu Book should be prepared based on nutritional guidelines, diversity in food, taste and preference of the students.
- MDM has played an important role in retention of students in schools and in completion of their primary education.
- Rural educated youth should be involved as Field Coordinators from the local areas, who can coordinate between Gram Pradhan and School Teachers on a cluster of 4-5 schools. These field coordinators will be responsible for making all logistics arrangement and record keeping related to MDM and will supervise the cooks-cumhelpers.
- Local catering/hotel management and other institutions should be engaged for delivering training to the Mid-day Meal Cooks-cum-Helpers. These institutions should be requested to design a Special Certificate Course for Mid-Day Meal Cooks-cum-Helpers.
- There is a need to link wages of the cook to price index so that the cooks continues to provide good services. Depending on the budget, the real wages can be improved by 5% every year for the cooks.
- One time payment of Rs. 5000 per school for purchasing and maintaining kitchen devices such as cooking chulha, utensils, food storage containers and serving plates are not sufficient as reported by most of the schools.
- A Model of Public-Private Partnership should be developed for establishment of central kitchen by involving corporate sector particularly catering, hotels and hospitality sector.
- Proper promotional strategy and media trageting need to be done for better coverage and media reach.
- Comprehensive, periodical and systematic orientation is mandatory to sensitize all stakeholders in order to understand this scheme well.
- There should be provision of MDM cell at each block level (Block coordinator and computer operator) to facilitate and run the scheme properly.
- Each school should be subjected to social auditing once in two years.
- IVRS system may be extended to other reporting like menu served/status of kitchen cum store/cook honorarium status/raw material availability etc for the further improvement of the scheme.
- It is also suggested that the present system of provision of food grain from the central government may be modified to provision of extra cost of food grain which may either be added to the conversion cost or may be provided separately in the name of food grain. This system will reduce the lengthy chain of supply of food grain from the central government to the school level.
